Leslie Rosenberg Inclusion Scholarship

The Leslie Rosenberg Inclusion Scholarship aims to enhance the learning community of Marin Waldorf School by broadening the opportunities for exceptional students hailing from diverse cultural, ethnic, and socioeconomic backgrounds, encompassing a wide array of talents, passions, and life journeys.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must maintain active enrollment in good standing.
- Families are required to submit a complete Tuition Assistance application.
- The application must be submitted in its entirety.

Selection Guidelines: The scholarship is bestowed upon students who most authentically embody the mission of LRIS. Preference for the LRIS scholarship is granted to students displaying significant financial need and a steadfast commitment to Waldorf education. This pertains particularly to those entering grade 6 or higher. Nevertheless, candidates applying for any class from Kindergarten to 5th grade are also eligible.



Every applicant is assessed based on the completion of a comprehensive application and their potential to contribute to the diversity of the MWS community. Additionally, students are evaluated in terms of academic accomplishments, involvement in the community, and potential for leadership. It is important to note that while each of these factors plays a role in the application assessment, no single factor singularly determines the outcome.

For the context of this scholarship, diversity is taken into account across one or more of the subsequent categories: cultural and linguistic background, religious beliefs, familial structure, socioeconomic class, gender identity and expression, racial identity, and varying abilities.
